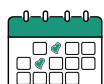

Geography

The country experiences distinct seasons, with hot summers and cold winters, which enhances **the diversity of plant and animal life**.

Currency



The currency of Jordan is **the Jordanian Dinar (JOD)**, which consists of 1000 fils. It was introduced as the official currency in 1949 and is considered one of the stable currencies in the region.
